BARREL FERMMENTED, CENTRAL COAST, ★★★★★+**

THE CENTRAL COAST IS SOFTLY TEXTURED, FULL BODIED, AND MODERATELY COMPLEX IN STYLE; A WINE WITH MODEST WOOD CHARACTER, AND RIPE FRUIT CHARACTER (PINEAPPLE). IT HAS OVERTONES OF ROASTED NUT AND HONEY.

**CASTLE ROCK CHARDONNAY 2010  
COLUMBIA VALLEY WA, ★★★★★**

THE COLUMBIA VALLEY IS A FULL BODIED, FRUITY STYLE OF CHARDONNAY. IT IS RELATIVELY CRISP, AND LONG ON THE FINISH, TASTING OF APPLE AND HONEYSUCKLE. FINE VALUE.

**CASTLE ROCK SAUVIGNON BLANC  
2010 MENDOCINO COUNTY, ★★★★★+**

EXTREMELY DISTINCT. FULL BODIED, ROUND, AND CRISP; A SAUVIGNON WITH GRAPEFRUIT, PEACH, LEMON PEEL, AND TROPICAL FRUIT AROMAS/FLAVORS. GREAT VALUE.

**CASTLE ROCK PINOT NOIR 2009  
CENTRAL COAST, ★★★★★**

THE 2009 CENTRAL COAST IS SOFTLY TEXTURED, FULL BODIED, AND FAIRLY INTENSE IN FLAVOR; A PINOT WITH JAMMY, SPICY, TOBACCO-LIKE AROMAS/FLAVORS, AND MEDIUM LENGTH.

**CASTLE ROCK PINOT NOIR 2009  
CARNEROS, ★★★★★**

THE CARNEROS BOTTLING IS FIRMLY STRUCTURED, MODERATELY INTENSE IN FLAVOR, AND MEDIUM LENGTH; A PINOT WITH VERY GOOD CHARACTER AT THE PRICE.

**CASTLE ROCK PINOT NOIR 2010  
MENDOCINO COUNTY, ★★★★★+**

THE 2010 MENDOCINO IS EXTREMELY GOOD: DISTINCTLY FLAVORED, FULL BODIED, AND CRISP, WITH MODERATE DEPTH AND A VERY LONG FINISH, TASTING OF PLUM, PEACH, RED CURRANT, AND ROSEHIPS.
