Our Castle Rock Pinot Noir is produced from grapes grown in the region of Los Carneros, one of the oldest and most prestigious Pinot Noir growing regions in California.

This elegant medium-bodied wine offers aromas of Cherry and herbal spice. On the palate this wine gives complex layers of cinnamon, spice, black cherry, sweet vanilla oak and floral notes, with a long velvety finish. Smooth with a silky texture and mild tannins, this versatile wine pairs well with lamb, chicken, veal, salmon, and light pasta dishes.
