## 2016 *Rosé of Pinot Noir* Mendocino County

### ✦ Tasting Notes

Our Castle Rock Rosé of Pinot Noir was produced from grapes grown in Northern California's beautiful Mendocino County, using the traditional French saignée method.

The wine is crisp, fresh and floral with bright acidity and aromas of violet and rose petals. On the palate it is supple and harmonious with flavors of strawberry, raspberry and citrus, with a smooth lingering finish. Perfect for drinking on its own, it also makes a nice accompaniment to salads, light past dishes and seafood.
