Our Castle Rock Pinot Noir is made from grapes grown in Oregon's Willamette Valley, an area which has gained international recognition as one of the most prestigious appellations for the cool-climate varietal. The elegant medium-bodied wine offers aromas of cherry, raspberry, and spiced tea. Bright acidity on the palate gives flavors of pomegranate and cranberry leading into its vibrant finish. It makes an excellent companion to roasted pork, chicken, smoked salmon, and a variety of pasta dishes.
